Saturday Pennant

Divisions 1 to 5 have had a smooth beginning to the pennant season apart from the change in the results procedure by Bowls Vic. A huge thank you to Bill Chilcott for everything he has done for all the clubs in the GVBD. His efforts in trying to unravel and make available to all clubs the information necessary to use the new system are nothing short of Herculean.

Applications for finals venues have been sent out to the clubs. Make sure that your club is willing and capable of meeting the criteria along with the provision of suitable greens. The Green's Committee will inspect greens closer to the finals and rank them according to their criteria. This information is then passed on to the WPMC for the selection of greens for our Finals. Last year's finals greens selections were excellent with all finals played on suitable surfaces and the events well run by the clubs involved. A couple of issues have arisen so far this season. Both seem to be resolved successfully after some coordination and agreement between all involved.

Abandonment of Game:

Confusion over the cancellation or abandonment of a game led to much discussion and some unnecessary postulating. The need for an instant resolution made for decisions being made in haste leading to the many law book readers in the GVBD jumping up in arms. Cancellation happens when the GVBD Weekend Pennant is called off before the event. This is either Friday night's weather report or by early Saturday morning giving all teams and clubs time to contact everyone involved that the day's play has been cancelled. The game will be replayed at a later date.

Abandonment happens when play has commenced and then has to be curtailed for some reason. Splitting the points is the result of this occurrence.

In the future with some masterly inactivity on the day and time for considered decisions from the Match Committee of the issue, we should see a calmer and more affable resolution to this type of situation.

Division 6 Issue

All GVBD clubs were canvassed to allow them to enter the teams that they thought they were capable of putting on the green. These were 4X4, 3X4 and 2X4. Only two clubs ended up wanting a 2X4 team which made a division 7 section unviable.

With 16 3X4 teams entered the WPMC asked the clubs with 2X4 if they thought they would be able to find enough players to make up a 16-team division 6 competition. They answered in the affirmative and the Division 6 East and West with a premiership for both divisions, was formed.

Some clubs then found that they were having trouble with fielding their team. 9 a side and forfeits began to happen. Clubs had also pulled their teams out of the competition. A decision that was made by the GVBD after considering information from the Match Committee, was later rescinded.

The division 6 now being 3X4 till the end of the season the clubs in this division (East and West) should assist each other in making this division work for all the players in all the teams each week of the season.

Strategies for clubs who find they are short of players include:

- Seeking help from clubs that have the bye for that week
- Asking neighbouring clubs for help with any players in excess for that week
- Seeking players through James McLeod's dossier of extra players for that week
- Clubs agreeing to Play 3X3 where necessary
- Clubs being agreeable to help out other clubs

For Players

- Playing for whichever club needs their help that week

Hopefully with clubs helping each other the Division 6 will remain a competition that is keen on keeping the maximum number of players participating each week.

Thanks to all the clubs for being so helpful and working with the WPMC this season. The WPMC looks forward to helping all clubs and players enjoy their bowls.

Most of the Women's State events have now been completed. It has been pleasing to see several different clubs involved in the finals.

The State Singles was won by Olivia Cartwright (Kyabram) over Jeanette Overall (Hill Top) in what I am assured was a wonderful display of bowls.

JUNIOR DEVELOPMENT & WEB CO-ORDINATION:

JUNIOR DEVELOPMENT:

Naomi and David Cartwright are doing a great job in managing the GV Devils, and in their promotion of the game of bowls.

The BV Roll Up program is currently underway, with Shepp Park and Hill top already having hosted the juniors. Currently play is at Kyabram on Monday evening still has a couple of sessions to go.

In January they will have a few teams entering the Strathmerton tournament and are looking at taking a team of 9 to the Junior Provincial Championships in Daylesford on the 15th January. This event won't cost us anything to enter but we may look at taking a bus. We would be looking for some support on this front.

In regard to funding Naomi had a few ideas to help support the kids in these events and especially the Under 18 Championships in April (we may need to hire a house for the week).

Funding ideas include running a raffle for the juniors to be run over the final series of the GV - each venue of the finals will have a book and we sell tickets \$2 each / 3 for \$5 and then we draw it on the Division 1 Grand final day.

The prizes for the raffle will be sourced and we look at getting vouchers and a wheelbarrow load of goodies. Approval from the GVBD Board is sought, before proceeding.

We are looking at running a bowls tournament during the January school holidays - 4th or 5th January and making it a twilight event 3 games of 8 ends starting at 5pm possibly triples? we would just need a venue for this and funds would help support the kids.

A few of the juniors are up for selection for the Vic under 18 tests against South Australia in January they will be announced soon.

GV Devils will be having a Christmas Break up for the DEVILS at Stanhope bowls club on the 18th Dec - we will play in their night bowls event on that night. - if you would like to join us or any of the GV board, that would be great.

WEBMASTER REPORT:

BowlsLink competition portal is up and running relatively successfully.

At the last meeting I had planned on not using it, as I felt it was not yet ready for release. This proved to be the case, and still some functions are not yet available, or do not work as we require.

Savage Bull continue to work on the software, and updates appear to be released monthly, although there is never any announcement of the upgrades.

Some of the shortcomings are: -

- No Skip ladder
- Unable to record a forfeit correctly (I fudge the shots and points for the defaulted side, but am unable to deduct shots for the defaulting side)

- Unable to record a heat out/washout correctly. (I fudge the result here also to award equal points)
- From the GVBD Results page, it is not easy to select the current round of a division. You must tap your way round to the desired round – it gets worse towards the end of season.

I have forwarded a list of shortcomings to Kelvin Rogers of BA for review. (a copy appended to the end of this report).

Kelvin has provided some notes, written by other users, and I have modified these and placed on the GVBD website.

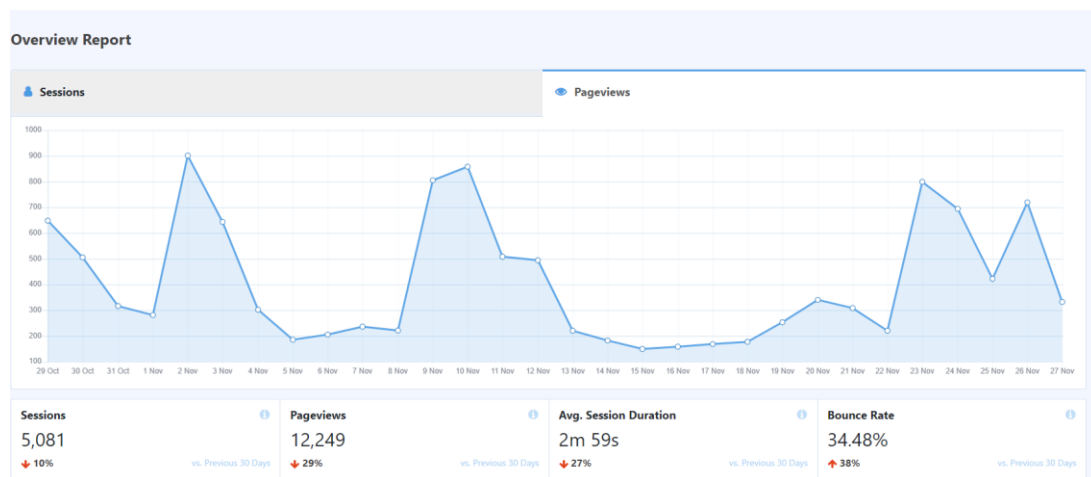
Club Administrators can nominate players to manage teams and results. These players must be listed as a team member (even if not playing in that division), and given the right to manage the results.

When first logging on, they will be asked for their email address where a code will be forwarded to them for confirmation. This means that club admins will need to ensure that the players details are correct and do contain a valid email address.

Club admins need to ensure that player currency is accurate, as at some stage in the future, non-financial members will not appear as available for pennant or any other official bowls event. At present GVBD has about 1230 members listed, and nearly 300 are listed as unfinancial.

Results entry compliance is performing very well, and is comparable to, or better than last years compliance. This is a great result, especially with the early entries being left to only one or two members of the clubs.

Results that are not confirmed will not show up on the ladder, even though the score show for the sides. An easy check for your club is to look at the ladder for each division and see that all sides have played the same number of games.

BOWLSLINK PROBLEMS and SHORTCOMINGS – NOT IN ANY ORDER

1. Manage Teams

Once the SUBSTITUTE is nominated for a position on a team, no further changes can be made to a player on any team for that side, until the SUBSTITUTE is removed and replaced by another player (generally non playing member).

FIXED

2. Manage Teams

When managing the teams and you accidentally try to put the same player into another team, the program (quite rightly) prevents this from occurring (Settings set to player can only play on one rink), However, when the SAVE button is pressed it needs to highlight where the problem is, or prevent the player appearing in the box for the second time.

FIXED

3. Pennant Training Guide (by WA Pennant Training)

Needs another section inserted between 1 & 2.

Setting up Initial Teams should flow similar to: -

1. Select Competition – Action In Play
2. Select Division – Action Manage Entries
3. Select Players – Action Edit
4. Select Add Player – select Link Member
5. Enter Member NID. - Search - Save
6. Repeat 4-5 as often as required.
7. Return to Competitions/My Club Entries at left.
8. Repeat 1-7 for remaining divisions.

Member National ID (NID) can be obtained from the Clubs Member list, and can be downloaded and printed for convenience. From Admin Login go to Membership – Select Exports - Action Download Report.

FIXED

4. From the above, when the Add Player box is opened, by starting to type a name in the box, all players meeting the criteria from the club's membership list should appear to make selection less laborious. (Similar to how it works in manage teams in Results section).

5. Using the BLUE buttons to IMPORT players from the membership list, in most cases only shows a few players from the club and is not a complete list of club members. (from what I've seen). Hence my suggestion in point 3.

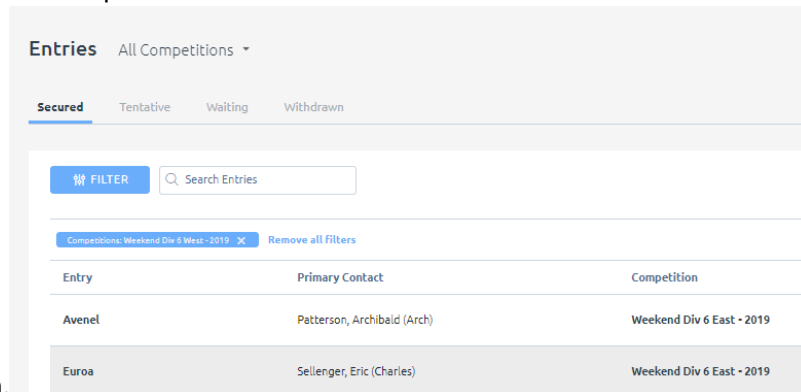

6. Referring to the RESULTS page,

When a competition is opened, it shows round 1/14. One must scroll/click their way through to the desired round to see the result. Would it be possible to use that bar to display the numbers 1-14 (or 18) to select the desired round immediately? Or better still to automatically open at the last played round.

When viewing a result sheet, add the option to expand/close all teams with a single button.

7. Allow Club Administrator to give access to team managers for team nomination and result entry. FIXED
8. When printing result sheet from the results section, can you fit a four-team match on a single page, rather than one line on the second page.
9. When selecting a division in the entries screen, choosing another selection from the All Competitions button, does not effect the change after you have made a change or inspection of the previous selection. You must then remove the filters and remake your



selection.

10. A general tidy up of terminology is required throughout the software. Eg finding a match for next weekend in the “In Play” or “Resulted” areas is counterintuitive.
11. When trying to remove a player’s name from a competition, there is no option to delete the entrant, other than mark as SUBSTITUT or UN PLAYED, which then causes the future selections to fail. Can we have a delete entrant button to leave the field blank. FIXED
12. When entering a new pennant Comp. and you label the Format/Specialisation as “Team 1-Team 4”, the order you enter them is not what shows on the results page, and you have to go back to edit to rearrange the labels to the correct order.
13. When Linking a member in the Entries details to replace an existing entry, only the primary contact name goes in, and the email and phone number have to be changed manually.
14. From the Club Administrators logon, they require a means of bulk updating members financial status. E.g. select several members and renew their “financial until” date as a single entry. The present system is an onerous task for larger clubs.
15. When a sub screen or box is opened, can the cursor be placed in the first available text box to save having to find the mouse and place the cursor.

- Many thanks to all selected Players for their contribution on the day.
- Unfortunately (Manager -Richard Warburton) hurt his finger prior to the commencement.
- Women's Team – came in second – carpet very slow.
- Many thanks to all selected Players for their contribution.

Report – Vic Open & support provided by Club Volunteers: -

GVBD Chairman (James McLeod) spoke to the meeting confirming his comments as detailed in his report and the report of Director (Gordon Nash) on the contribution of Club Volunteers in supporting the Vic Open for 2019. Huge thanks to all.

Weekend Pennant -Division 6 -East and West: –

GVBD Chairman (James McLeod) reported to the meeting on the Weekend Division 6 East and West Pennant sides: -

- Weekend Division 6 Pennant structure of East & West will remain the same for the 2019-2020 season of 12 Players per side.
- If Clubs are unable to field a team of 12 players, they may (Bowler's Handbook - RULE 19, Page 97) co-opt another emergency player from their own or another Club.
- If Clubs are unable to field a team of 12 Players, they may play with a minimal of 9 players, with 3 players on each rink (2 bowls each).
- Clubs can also source emergency players through Pennant Co-Ordinator (James McLeod) or from the team that has the bye for that week in Division 6.

Up-date Men's & Women's Ovens & Murray Challenge – 15th December 2019: -

- The Challenge to be played at Benalla Bowls Club.
- Ovens & Murray – 2019 Host for both the Men's & Women's Challenge.
- Both Men's & Women's Team will play two games of 18 Ends.
- GVBD Executive Board – paying for Coach (Bus) to transport Players and Supporters.
- Noting Supporters most welcome.
- GVBD Men's Official Rink selected to play.
- No Official Women's Rink.
- Advice communicated to Clubs on the selected Men's & Women's Teams for the Challenge.

Up-date Bowls Victoria – Boundary/Division proposed changes.: -

GVBD Chairman (James McLeod) spoke to the meeting advising of recent discussion held with Bowls Victoria Representatives, whom advised that within their Constitution must undertake a review of Bowls Victoria boundaries.

Feedback has indicated that there may be no changes – Bowls Victoria to feedback – advice no-one to panic at this time.

Board & Clubs – Discussion Time – in reference to the following: -

- **WEEKEND Pennant Grand Finals – Division 1 & 2 (Sunday).**
- **Division 3:4:5:6E and 6W (Saturday):-**

GVBD Chairman (James McLeod) spoke to the meeting to Weekend Pennant Grand Finals. Weekend Match & Pennant Chairperson (Sue Tyson) also spoke detailing the Match Committee proposal for the 2019/20 Season Pennant Grand Finals.

- Division 1 & 2 play on the Sunday -One Venue – Division 2 (In morning) and Division 1 (Afternoon) – feeling of the meeting both finals be held at the same time.
- Divisions 3:4:5: 6E and 6W – all play at One venue on the Saturday.
- Discussion points – reduces travelling: Clubs supporting: Volunteers: Raffle: and bigger crowds.

Clubs asked to discuss with their Bowling Members and report back to the GVBD Board and Weekend Match & Pennant Committee.

Board & Clubs -Discussion Time – In reference to directive from Bowls Victoria: -

GVBD Chairman (James McLeod) reported to the meeting on recent discussion held with Bowls Victoria following the introduction of Bye in Division One – Midweek Pennant for 2019/20 Season.

James explained Bowls Victoria stated that GVBD must undertake a review of the following: -

- Promotion/Relegation:
- Midweek Pennant Restrictions:
- Open – Midweek Pennant
- Midweek Survey.

GVBD Secretary (Joy O'Donnell) spoke to the meeting stating the following: -

- ***Promotion/Relegation*** – Refer to current Rule 28 -Page 99 GVBD Handbook.
- Plus, no two Club Teams playing in the same Division.
- Currently in Midweek Pennant Division 4 – has Shepparton Park with 2 teams.

- This has come about with the GVBD Board seeking approval for a Bye in Division One Midweek Pennant this season.

Board Recommendation:

Club Premiers – promoted. Bottom of the Ladder -Relegated.

- Midweek Pennant – Open
- Midweek Pennant – Restrictions
- Midweek Pennant -Survey.

Noting if Open Midweek Pennant – no restrictions or survey required.

Board Recommendation:

Remembering Equal Opportunity Act – All Players selected on ABILITY not GENDER

- OPEN Midweek Pennant – commencing 2020/21 Season.

Clubs were reminded it is the Clubs themselves who select their Players to play Pennant – Not the Board.

All Club Representatives in attendance asked to discuss the detailed points and report back to the next General Meeting to be held in February 2020.

Please note – This is a DISCUSSION – No formal decision has been decided at this time.

VIC Open – Taylor Bowls:

Gordon Thompson (Murchison) spoke to the meeting reminding all Clubs involved in the recently held Vic Open to place their order for their Taylor Bowls.

East Shepparton Bowls Club: -

East Shepparton Bowls Club Representative (Noel O’Brien) raised the issue of coloured hats being worn.

Following discussion Representatives indicated if it was a registered appropriate hat, they saw no issue.
